Happy 2025! Thank you to those who gave a special gift this Christmas! We sure are glad that Jesus is the reason for every season! We started the new year with a revival service on January 1st, where we unveiled the theme of “Building Lives in 2025” and prayed at the altar for God’s power to reach more souls this year! As we know, Satan is in the business of blinding people to the Gospel and destroying lives... but Thank God, Jesus is in the business of saving, salvaging, and building lives through the bright light of the Gospel and His Word! It is our desire that God would use us ever increasingly to this end! We praise God, that last year, we saw many souls saved and 201 souls baptized. Please help us pray for greater works in 2025!



SUPPORTING, SENDING, AND EXTENDING!

At the end of 2024, we held our very first “Mission Month” and challenged all the people to commit to giving towards sending and supporting world wide missions! The Philippines is a very poverty stricken country with most of the people living on the equivalent of \$2 a day. Yet out of their deep poverty, God’s people committed. We had several missionary families in and by God’s grace, we were able to support 3 new missionary families! We also had a family out of our church (Dizon family), surrender to the full time work of the Lord! Praise God for His plan and design that the local church be a great sending station for missionaries to the different Islands of the Philippines and beyond!



CHURCH ANNIVERSARY, PRAYING FOR 1,000+ FIRST TIME VISITORS!

In the Philippines, Almost 85-90% of the population is Roman Catholic. They will not come to a Baptist Church without a soul winner personally bringing them. Even with an invite, the vast majority will be hesitant and resistant. However, in Filipino culture, they love celebrations (carried over from when the Spanish ruled here). They will come if there is an “Anniversary celebration.” For that reason, we make a big deal about our church anniversary and use the occasion as a great opportunity to invite people, give them the gospel, and pray to see many people saved! This year we are praying and working to have over 1,000 first time visitors! We have rented a large sports arena and are begging God to fill it up with souls to hear the Gospel. I have invited Pastor Dan Preston of the Bethany Baptist Church of Lubbock Texas to be our guest preacher. Please pray for us, and for many souls to be saved! The date is March 2nd 2025!
