Happy Thanksgiving from our family to yours! We have much to be thankful for and we're glad to be able to spend the day with family in the US of A! This letter spans a couple of months and 7,169 miles from the Republic of Nauru to New Castle, Indiana

## **Preparing to Leave Nauru**

We had a few projects to get done around the house before the Crafts arrived. We levelled ground, backfilled, put up forms and then mixed & poured concrete around the back of the house which was a huge job (over 30 square yards/meters). We'd been putting off for a while and were very glad when it was all done. Titus and Gideon were a huge help, so we will probably keep feeding them;) We set up scaffolding and repainted some of the window trim and also put up guttering on the front of the house and ran PVC pipe to connect the gutter to the main water tank. It's been dry, but should it rain again the water will hopefully end up in our tank which will be a blessing:)

We also got our new church sign mounted before we left.

## Preparing to Leave Nauru

Gary and Karen Craft arrived on the 13th November and we hit ground running getting them a Nauruan Drivers License and bank account all set up. We showed them all around Nauru and enjoyed getting to know them before we flew out on the 20th of November.

## Travel - are we there yet?

We flew to Australia and spent 6 days with my family and flew down to Sydney on a Tuesday and onto Honolulu, Hawaii arriving in the morning to start our full second Tuesday! How many Tuesdays did your week have!?;) Wednesday we flew to Las Vegas and onto Indianapolis and got in at 1am Thanksgiving day. After some sleep we spent Thanksgiving with family and were so glad to be home for it.

We have been settling in well and slowly getting over jet lag, and enjoying catching up with friends and family and our home church family. Thank you to those who prayed for the Craft's arrival our safe travels back to the States, we appreciate it and look forward to reporting to churches face to face during our furlough.
